

# Explanation of Judges' Scoring Sheets for Simulation Events (Water Rescue and First Aid)

This is designed as a guideline for competitors and officials to assist with the understanding of the different elements found on the Simulation Events' scoring sheets. All of the expectations are related to official documents from the Lifesaving Society, including <u>Alert</u>, <u>The Canadian Lifesaving Manual</u>, appropriate award guides. Please review these documents along with this explanation sheet. Different items apply to different sheets. Please refer to the sheets for details (i.e. Speed of Recognition is only found on Water Rescue sheets). The telephone and overall scoring sheets include detail with each item.

### Scores (0, 1, 2, 3)

 $\mathbf{0}$  – not attempted

1 – attempted, but 1 or more significant items performed below NLS/FA standard (i.e. would fail NLS/FA)

2 – all or the majority of items performed at NLS/FA standard (i.e. would pass NLS/FA)

3 – all items performed at or above NLS/FA standard with exceptional attention to detail in one or more areas

### Speed of Recognition and Response

• Recognition and response time

### Rescue Scene Assessment

- Check for and management of hazards
- Determine mechanism of injury
- Incident history
- Major complaint/other injuries
- Assess for spinal
- Appropriate entry/approach/contact with victim

#### **Primary Assessment**

- Determine Level of Consciousness
- Establish and assess airway
- Assessment of breathing and circulation
- ABC's assessed as early as possible
- Gross haemorrhage/body sweep
- Assessment of primary complaint

#### Treatment items

 Treatment items are specific for each victim. They have been taken directly from Must See's in conjunction with the manuals as listed above. Please refer to these manuals for additional information. Treatment includes monitoring and management of ABC's as well as treating for shock and use of oxygen if trained.

### Secondary Assessment

- Determine victim's medical history
- Complete head-to-toe, hands on body check in a logical manner
- Quality and appropriateness of body check (attention to detail)

### Continuing Assessment

- Vitals monitored throughout
- Airway maintained throughout
- Injuries monitored/assessed throughout
- Identify changing conditions (if necessary)
- Appropriate response to changes in condition (if necessary)

#### Communication and Victim Care Throughout

- Communication performed with confidence, calmness and reassurance, including introducing themselves
- Necessary information was obtained from victim and witnesses
- Interaction with other guards was appropriate and effective
- Interaction with witnesses was appropriate and effective
- Confidence/calmness in dealing with victim
- Treatment performed in a logical manner
- Treatment at earliest possible moment
- Prevention of further injury
- Appropriate or minimal movement of victim (including removal)
- Effective response
- Effective use of equipment
- Use of protective equipment and barrier devices

# WATER RESCUE AND FIRST AID EVENTS SCORING EXPLANATION

The score sheets for the Water Rescue and First Aid events have been designed based on the principles of rescue and lifesaving supported by the Lifesaving Society.

All of the expectations are related to official documents from the Lifesaving Society, including the following:

- Alert
- The Canadian Lifesaving Manual
- Appropriate award guides

Points have been allocated for items to reflect priorities of treatment and victim care (i.e. basic lifesaving and first aid). As well, a minor score sheet is worth exactly half of a major score sheet. It may be helpful to examine the points based on percentages, as the actual points assigned may seem arbitrary. Percentages have been determined based on past history, consistency, manuals and official documents from the Lifesaving Society.

Percentages of points are as follows (they are not identical between categories in order to allocate even points):

As well, consistency has been established among the sheets. For example, on the minor laceration score sheet, apply cold has a potential value of 20 points. For that item, if the competitor scores a 1 they will receive 8 points; if earn a 2 they will receive 12 points and if they receive a 3 they receive 20 points. This same point distribution occurs whenever an item has a potential value of 20 points, even on a different score sheet. So, on the minor fracture score sheet, a distal circulation check is also worth up to 20 points and if a competitor earns a 1 they will receive 8 points, for a 2 they will receive 12 points and for a 3 they will receive 20 points.



# Explanation of Judges' Scoring Sheet for Telephone (Water Rescue and First Aid)

This is designed as a guideline for competitors and officials to assist with the understanding of the telephone scoring sheet. All elements are to simulate an emergency phone call as closely to a real EMS phone call as possible and will assist with the set-up of the phone when one is used in simulated events.

### Telephone Guidelines:

- The phone must be a physical phone
- At no time will an official identify that they are the phone judge
- The phone receiver or portable unit must be picked up and 9-1-1 manually initiated to start the scoring process (CCM 4.7, pg. 37 Scoring communication with officials "competitors are responsible for making their actions and intentions clear to the judges")
- Phone points will only be given for Major Victims
- Points are allotted for phone calls made after the major victim's condition becomes apparent.
- No points are awarded for making a phone call for a victim who does not (yet) require emergency response.
- Phone calls may not be updated

#### Water Rescue

• The phone will be found at the location of the actual emergency phone as identified by the host facility. In cases where the identified location is not feasible, the location will be identified during the coaches meeting.

#### First Aid

- It will be identified during the coaches meeting if a phone will or will not be available.
- The phone location will not be given.

### Initiate Phone Call

- Once the phone receiver or portable unit has been picked up and 9-1-1 has been manually initiated the judge will say; "Fire, Police, or Ambulance."
- 5 marks will be given when the emergency service is requested

### Dispatcher (Judge prompted)

- How many victims are you calling for?
  - o Identify the number of victims
- Is your victim conscious or unconscious?
  - o Identify if the victim is conscious or unconscious
- Is your victim breathing or non-breathing?
  - o Identify if the victim is breathing or non-breathing
- What is your victim type?
  - o Identify the correct victim type
- Repeat the above 3 questions for each victim
- Confirm location/address
  - The judge will say; "Can you confirm that your location is (fill in the blank)." (address will be preidentified to the competitors)
- Confirm call back phone number
  - The judge will say; "Can you confirm that your phone number is (fill in the blank)." (phone number will be pre-identified to the competitors)
- Where will you meet us?
  - The location will be pre-identified to the competitor and the competitor must correctly identify the location (e.g. the main doors) to receive full points

### Speed of Phone Call (from time of incident)

- Speed of call marks will be timed from the time of the incident and not from the time that the situation starts
- Marks are allotted once the 9-1-1 call has been initiated
